

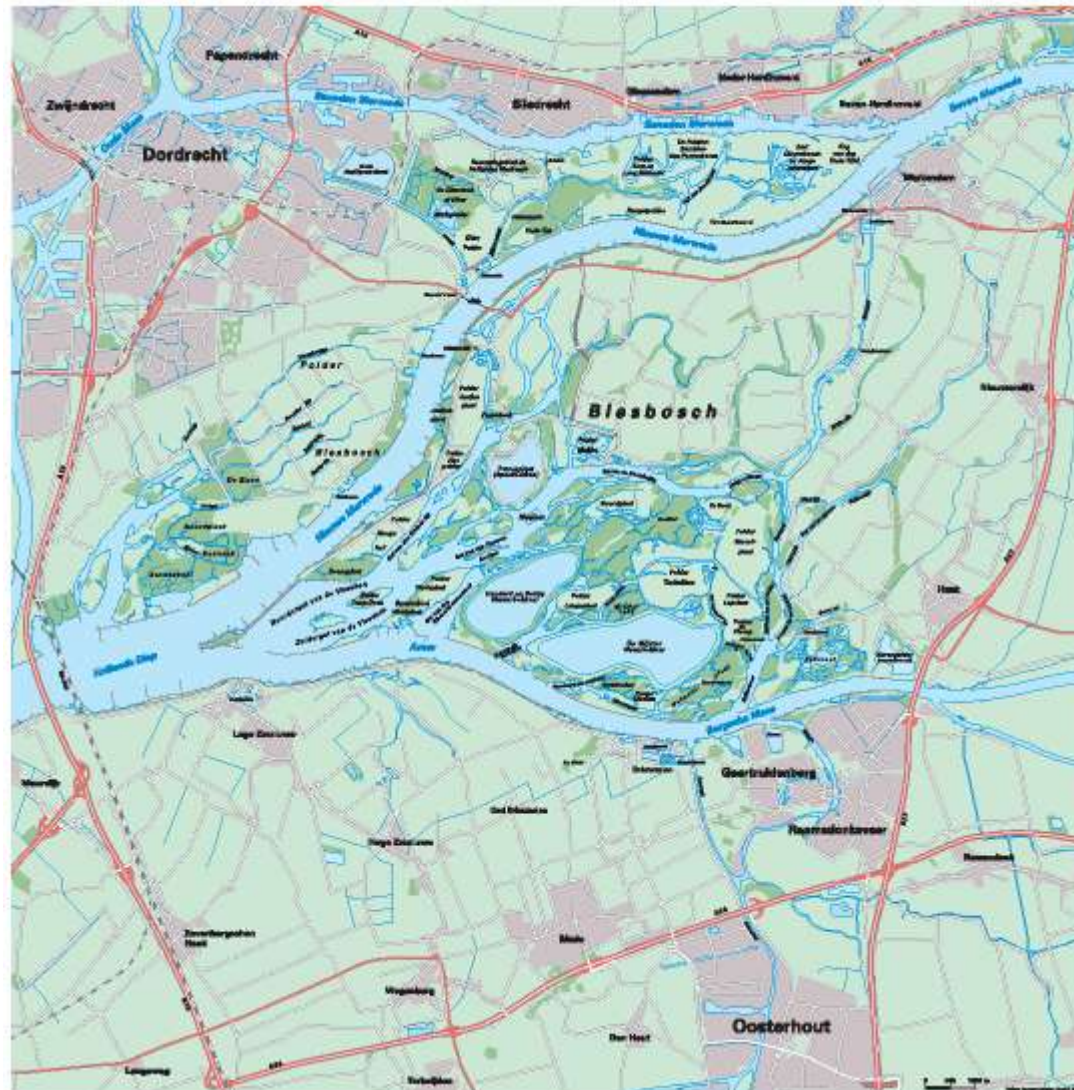

Sustainable in several levels

Zones

- Intensive forms of recreation in the outside part
- Extensive forms of recreation in the inner part
- Looking for motive groups:
 - a. seeker for nice things, b. seeker for just a few moments, c. seeker for interest, d. seeker for nature and landscape d. seeker for challenge
- Difference in facilities
- Information
- Surveillance and maintenance

- To realize a variety of eco-lodges
- To make the most sustainable visitor- centre of Europe
- Study landing stages with facilities for electric navigations

Where are we at this moment?

- Research for preference of watersporter has ended, a clearly view of preference, locations, accommodations etc
- Research landing stages with facilities for electric navigations start in july in combination with tracks for bikes
- Research for tracks, eco-lodges facilities and waterferries, start march and finish july 2010
- Research for visitor centre, start in october 2010 with a expert meeting
- Realizing electric boat, period juni till and december 2010
